2.0 Old Items

2.1 CHRONIC ABSANTEE RATES & UPDATES

- The attendance rates for each grade levels are; 8th grade 28.3%, 7th grade 23.7% and 6th grade 24%.
- Re-allotted resources: We have one AP working with monitoring attendance along with one OSII.
- Strategic ways to approach our chronic absentees: parent contact; TPOP program; get parents engaged and CIS.
- The counselors and administration are looking at retentions and credit denial for students with chronic absentees and it is non-negotiable.

2.2 TIER I INSTRUCTION INITIATIVE

- Monday mornings – Meet with leadership team
- Tuesdays afternoon – Talk to teachers and have purposeful planning.
- Wednesday – meet with all staff
- Thursday mornings, PLC meeting. Administration and Learning Strategist are working directly with teachers and focusing on ELA, Math and Science.

2.3 AZAC UPDATES

- Mack MS is no longer an option for rezoning.
- Monaco, Keller, Martin and Smith are still an option for rezoning our 6th and 7th grade students.

- The date was changed from May 2 to May 16; time will be at 5:00 – 7:00 pm.
- The event will be a mandatory event for all teachers to attend.
- Looking at having food trucks, special speaker.
- Funding coming from SGF, we will be reaching out to vendors and fundraising options.

3.1 SCHOOL/STAFFING UPDATES

- We have a new CSM joining our school starting January 29.
