2.0 Old Items

2.1 CHRONIC ABSANTEE RATES & UPDATES

- The chronic absentee rates dropped down to 18.5% rate. The State absent rate is currently at 13.8%.
- We have more students involved in sports and activities. There was an improvement in parent communication.

2.2 50th Celebration Updates

- Ms. Wadas, Assistant Principal shared that there is over 1,000 families who have completed the interest form to attend on May 16th from 5-7pm
- There has been over 400 logs, post on our school web pages of pictures and stories.
- There will be collages added to some rooms and will have some Robison shirts available for sale. We will have pre-order shirts available on our school website.

2.3 CREDIT RETRIEVAL PROGRESS

- Mr. Brill shared that Edgenuity program is now in place. Students have to option of completing their work during the school day or work from home as well.
- Students can complete the program in two to three weeks.

2.4 SBAC

- We have our school wide SBAC testing starting April 8, 2025. The largest testing class will be for 22 students and the rest are between 18-20 students per class.
- Students who are present and complete the SBAC testing will receive various incentives.

3.0 New Items

3.1 SCHOOL/STAFFING UPDATES

- Currently we have 41 instruction days left.
- Surplus for teachers and support staff will be starting on April 16th.
- Currently, 6 out of 38 support staff have a job for the next school year.
- We have nine teachers who have not accepted a job for the 25-26 school year.
- The administrative team do not know what will happen to their jobs, but what we know is that we will have to interview. There is no surplus for administration team.

3.2 COUNSELORS REPORT

- Counselors are now at the second round of Magnet Schools notifications; students who were accepted are now accepting their seats.
- Edgenuity program has 140 student enrolled.
- Retention letters and retentions for students that have ½ credit will be notified and letters will be mailed out at the end of Q3. Counselors will meet one-on-one with students.
- Straight A, A/B's and O's student celebration will be on March 28, there will be 63 students who will be participating and we will have Cane's for lunch.
- Over 400 students have picked their electives for Keller, Roy Martin and Monaco for the 25-26 school year.

3.3 COMMUNITIES IN SCHOOLS

- CIS continues to building connections with the students, focusing in building one-on-one connections.
- Continue to work on student attendance and improvements were made with 22 out of 24 students who CIS was working with.
- CIS is having conversations with students about their future and the change for next school year. The focus is to try to ease their anxiety over the school transition.
