3.0 New Items

3.1 CCSD SBAC TESTING. Information

- Ms. Ravalo shared a copy of the “Spring 2023 Testing Schedule”. She explained and reviewed the dates & plans of each test.
 - *WIDA testing was completed during the month of February, WIDA is for our EL students.*
 - *SBAC reading testing was held last week, students are working on their Math testing this week. We are mandated to have 95% student participation in all categories.*
 - *Science CRT testing was held last week for 8th grade students only.*
 - *MAP testing is held 3 times a year. We should be having our last MAP testing for this school year.*
 - *Middle School students do not have End of Course Exams with the exemption of Algebra.*
- Ms. Ravalo shared that students should be able to attend Summer Acceleration after Memorial Day.

3.2 CCSD PAPER TUTORING SUPPORT. Information

- Ms. Ravalo shared the new program and plan from CCSD “Paper Tutoring Support”. It is a website that provides support to CCSD students and has been available since the beginning of the school year.
 - *Support is available 24/7 tutoring support through Clever.*
 - *Our school is helping our students’ login & teachers are tasked to get all students logged in through their math classes.*

3.3 COUNSELING DEPT: GRADES AND PRE-REGISTRATION FOR 23-24. Information

- Ms. Bunse shared that 8th grade students are pre-registering for High School.
 - Previously Desert Pines HS visited our school campus and our students were able to pre-register for their classes.
 - Incoming 6th grade students visited our campus and were able to select classes through a survey our counselors provided.
 - Our current 8th grade students visited Eldorado High School and toured their school.
 - Our current 6th & 7th grade students will complete a survey to pre-register for their classes for next school year.
- The counselors are focusing on the current 7th & 8th grade retention student list.
 - Most of the 7th grade students are making progress with the exemption of three students who did not show improvement.
 - For the 8th graders, 25 students who were in the retention list were off probation, there are 13 students in probation but making improvement. There are two 8th grade students with no progress and one student with attendance issues.

 - We currently have one open Instructional Assistant support staff position.
