

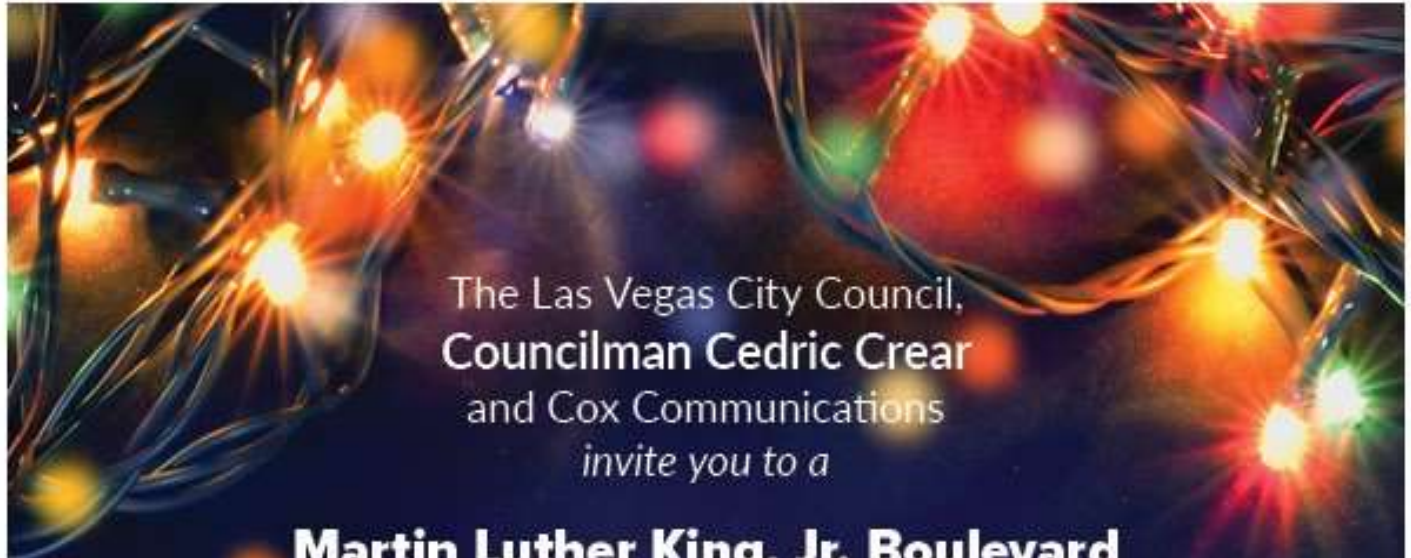

Overdose Prevention Training

This one hour, in-person training will teach individuals how to recognize signs of opioid overdose and respond to the situation, including administering the life-saving medication Naloxone. Naloxone (brand name Narcan) reverses the effects of an opioid overdose and all attendees will leave equipped with an overdose kit that contains nasal or intramuscular Naloxone along with a certificate of completion upon request.

HOLIDAY CRIME PREVENTION TIPS



Out & About:

- Practice the buddy system and shop with a friend.
- Do not leave gifts, valuables, or packages in your car in plain sight. Place all items, including your purse, in the trunk BEFORE you get to your next destination.
- Always be aware of your surroundings.
- Park in well-lit areas at night.
- Do not be distracted while walking to and from your car.
- Have your car keys out when leaving the store so you are not caught distracted while searching for them.
- Do not keep large amounts of cash on your person. Using a credit card is best.

In your Home:

- Keep doors and windows locked at all times.
- Place your tree and gifts where they can not be seen from the outside.
- Do not ignore a knock at your door. Acknowledge them through the door, but do not feel pressured to open the door for strangers.
- Break down empty boxes (TV's, computers, etc.) and make sure they fit in your trash cans. Do not place the boxes visibly next to the trash cans.

Out of Town:

- Have your home looked after by a trusted neighbor, friend, or family member.
- Ask a neighbor to pick up any packages that are left at your front door, or have them sent to the post office.
- Place lights on photocell or timers so they turn on when you would normally be home.



CONSEJOS PARA LA PREVENCIÓN DEL CRIMEN DURANTE LOS DIAS FESTIVOS

Afuera del Hogar:

- Si se puede, no vaya de compras a solas, lleve a alguien con usted.
- No deje regalos, objetos de valor, paquetes, en su automóvil a la vista. Coloque todos sus artículos, incluyendo su bolsa, en la cajuela ANTES de llegar a su próxima ubicación.
- Este siempre atento a su entorno.
- Estacione en áreas bien iluminadas durante la noche.
- No se distraiga mientras camina hacia y desde su automóvil.
- Saque las llaves del auto cuando salga de la tienda para que no le atrapen mientras esta buscándolas.
- No guarde grandes cantidades de efectivo en su persona. Es mejor usar tarjetas de crédito.

En Su Hogar:

- Mantenga todas las puertas y ventanas cerradas.
- Coloque árboles y regalos donde no se puedan ver desde afuera.
- No ignore si le tocan la puerta. Responda por detrás de su puerta y no le abra a extraños.
- Descomponga las cajas vacías (de televisores, computadoras, etc.) y asegúrese de que quepan en sus botes de basura. No deje que se vea por fuera que producto venia en las cajas.

Si sale de la ciudad:

- Pídale a un vecino, amigo, o familiar de confianza que cuide su hogar.
- Pídale a un vecino que recoja cualquier paquete que llegue a su hogar, o pueden ser enviarlos a la oficina de correo por mientras que regresa.
- Coloque luces de fotocélula o temporizadores para que se enciendan cuando normalmente estaría en casa.

No, CoxWiFi is a virtual network; you do not need a dedicated hotspot device to connect to the CoxWiFi network.

Is the CoxWiFi network secure?

Cox makes reasonable efforts to provide a secure service. Still, because the service is wireless, we strongly recommend that you ensure any devices you connect to are first protected by anti-virus/anti-malware software and that your operating system firewall is turned on to provide additional protection. 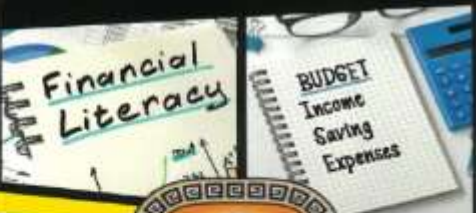

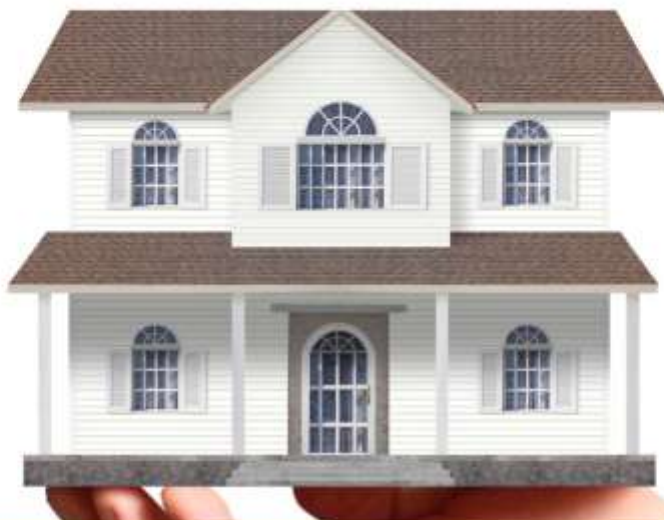

6 THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT COVID-19 VACCINATION FOR CHILDREN

1. COVID-19 vaccination for children is safe

Before recommending COVID-19 vaccination for children, scientists conducted studies and determined the Pfizer vaccine is safe and effective for children ages 5 and older.

Ongoing safety monitoring shows that COVID-19 vaccination continues to be safe for children and the benefits of the COVID-19 vaccine outweigh the known and potential risks.

Tips for Parents and Caregivers:

- Before vaccination, tell the vaccine provider about any allergies your child may have — just like what you would do when they receive their routine vaccines.
- If needed, request accommodations at COVID-19 vaccination sites: When making an appointment or arriving for vaccination, you can let clinic staff know your child needs accommodations for their physical, developmental, behavioral, or emotional differences. If needed, homebound services can be requested by calling 855-635-0235 or emailing homebound@snhd.org.

2. Getting vaccinated helps protect children against COVID-19

Vaccinating children can:

- Prevent children from getting seriously sick if they do get COVID-19. COVID-19 vaccination continues to protect children against serious disease and hospitalization. There is no way to tell in advance how children will be impacted by COVID-19. Children with underlying medical conditions are more likely to get severely ill; however, healthy children without underlying medical conditions can also experience severe illness.
- Keep children safer while in childcare and school and participating in sports, playdates, extracurricular activities, and other group activities.

3. Children may have some side effects after the COVID-19 vaccination.

Reported side effects are like those experienced after routine vaccinations. Side effects may affect your child's ability to do daily activities, but they should go away within a few days and are more common after the second shot. Some children do not experience side effects.



4. A different dosage of the COVID-19 vaccine is given to children.

The COVID-19 vaccine for children has the same active ingredients as the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine given to people ages 12 years and older. However, the Pfizer vaccine for children ages 5 through 11 years is a smaller dose. COVID-19 vaccine dosage is based on age on the day of vaccination, not the patient's weight. This is also true for other routinely recommended vaccines, like hepatitis A and hepatitis B vaccines.

5. Children who have already had COVID-19 should still get vaccinated.

Emerging evidence is showing that people can get added protection by getting vaccinated after they have been infected with the virus that causes COVID-19.

If your child tests positive for COVID-19 after getting their first shot, they should wait until their recommended isolation period has ended before getting their second shot. The second dose is recommended at least four weeks after the first dose. For children, 12 years and older without a weakened immune system, the time between doses one and two can be at least eight weeks.

6. Children can safely receive other vaccines the same day they receive their COVID-19 vaccine.

Routine vaccination is important preventive care that should not be delayed. If your child is receiving multiple vaccines during a single visit, each injection will be given in a different injection site, according to vaccine recommendations by age.

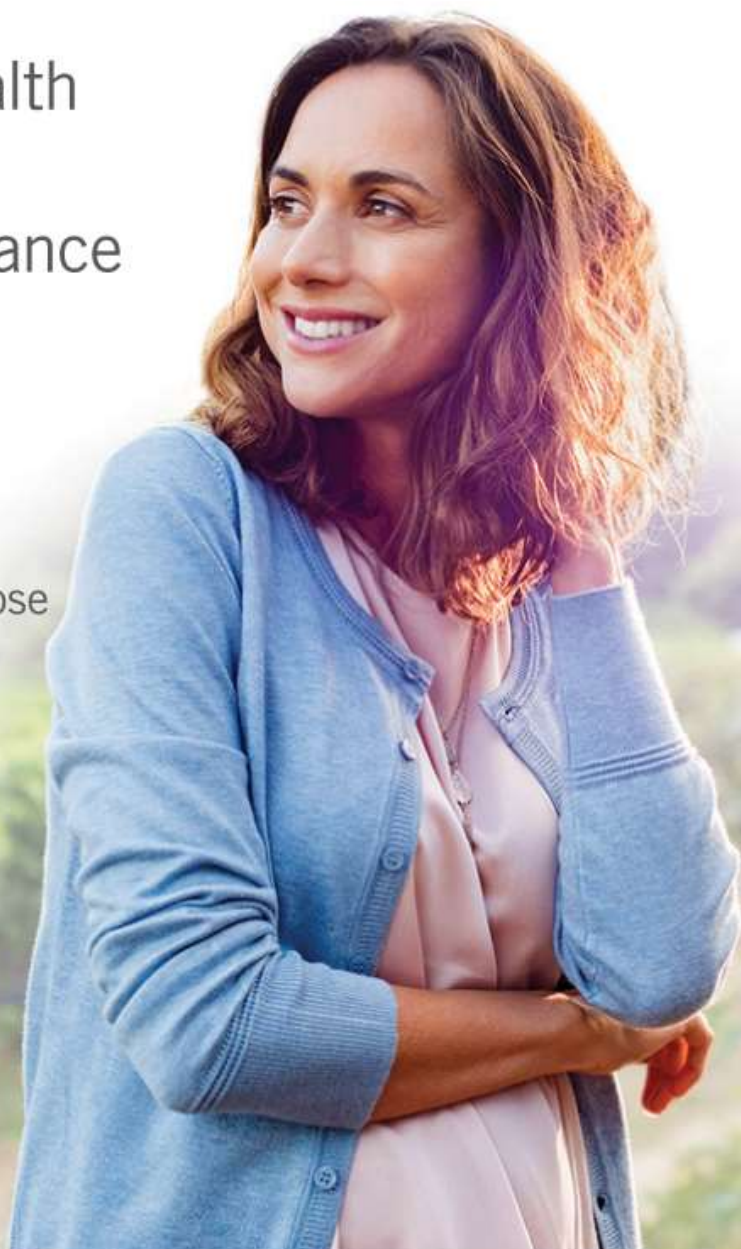

ABOUT FOSTER CARE

Foster care means families helping families.

Children who enter foster care are removed from their homes due to abuse or neglect. The goal of foster care is to ensure children can be safely reunited with their birth family.

Foster parents are an important part of strengthening families in our community. Foster parents provide a safe, nurturing, and temporary homes for children as they await reunification.

TYPES OF FOSTER CARE

- **FAMILY FOSTER CARE**

Provides ongoing care to children and youth while a permanency plan is implemented.

- **ICARE**

Emergency care for children from birth to under the age of 18. Family is available 24/7 and the child is in the home up to 30 days.

- **ADVANCED FOSTER CARE**

Children who have been assessed for Advanced Foster Care have difficulty regulating their emotions and may present challenging behaviors. These children have often had multiple placements and need extra support in making a successful transition to foster care.



FOSTER PARENT REQUIREMENTS

- Be at least 21 years of age.
- Be able to meet basic income guidelines.
- Be able to provide adequate bedroom space & a separate bed for each foster child.
- Have reliable transportation.
- Be willing to complete foster parent training.
- Be willing for every adult in your household to undergo complete background checks.
- Be in the home you wish to be licensed

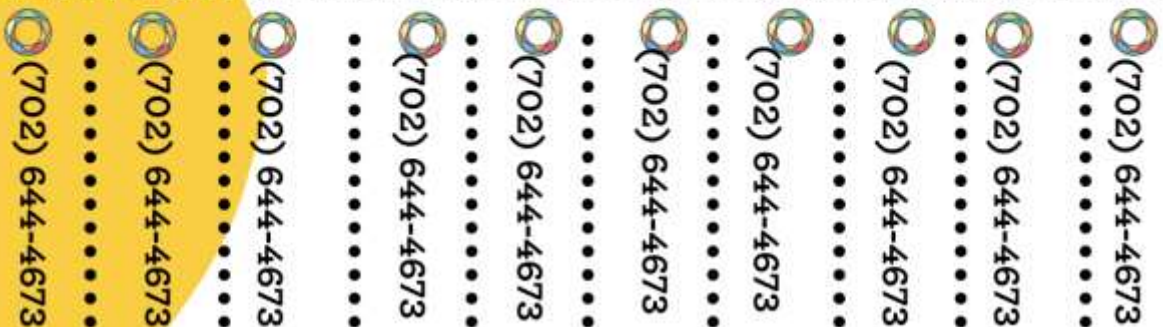

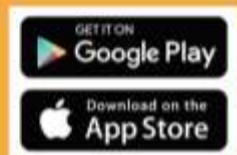

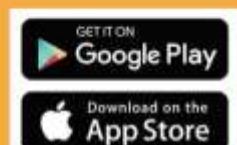
