1.0 Welcome & Roll Call

Meeting was called to order by principal, Immer Liza Ravalo.

2.0 Old Items

2.1 ENROLLMENT NUMBERS AND ATTENDANCE. Information.

- Ms. Ravalo reported that our enrollment numbers are at 85% of our projected enrollment and currently working on enrolling more students.
 - *We have 863 students who are currently enrolled.*
 - *Count day is September 10th*
 - *We need higher enrollment numbers to keep all our teachers.*
- Ms. Karas asked about online Learning. Ms. Ravalo said that at Robison we do not have online classes, we only have face-to-face. NV Learning Academy is the option for students who wish to attend online classes for the 21-22.
- Ms. Ravalo shared that at NV Learning Academy they have over 7,000 students and need 90 additional teachers to teach online, CCSD is looking to hire more teachers for online classes.

2.2 GRADING REFORM RESOURCES. Information.

- Ms. Ravalo shared that the community knows that CCSD has started to implement the Grading Reform. We at Robison started to inform and remind our parents and community of the grading changes in the spring.
 - Grading Reform will be a three (3) year process
 - Parents/tutors will still see grades A, B, C, D and F's.
 - The grading will consist of 50 – 59% grade percentage for F's.
 - Students will have the opportunity to make up any late work and take test to help fix their quarterly grade.
 - No changes can be made once the semester ends.

3.0 New Items

3.1 COUNSELING DEPT. Information.

- Ms. Staluppi shared that the Counseling Department will be working on the CCSD Panoramic Survey for students. CCSD implemented the survey to check on the well-being and to determine how students are feeling. The survey will be given to students on September 14, 15 and 16th

- Ms. Schau introduced herself as the Title I representative for Robison MS. Ms. Schau shared important information about the 21-22 Budget information.
 - During Open House it was shared that 465K was allocated to our school, it was 100K less than last school year as result of enrollment decrease.
 - Title I has purchased more chromebooks to make sure all students get an assigned a device.
 - Money was allocated to staff teachers and lower the class sizes.
 - Teacher will receive pay outside their contracted hours to collaborate and plan as a team.
